SCOTTISH AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP 2022

Title and Jurisdiction

- 1 The Scottish Association of Motorsports Clubs (hereinafter referred to as the SAMSC) will promote a Clubman status Championship to be known as the < Scottish Autotest Championship 2022>.
- 2 The Championship will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), The Motorsport UK and Local Government **COVID-19** Guidelines for Events, these Championship Regulations and any written instructions the Championship and the organizing Clubs may issue.

Competitor Eligibility

- 5 Any person who is a fully elected member of a recognised Club within SAMSC and any other invited Clubs or Association listed on an individual events Supplementary Regulations. All entrants must produce a valid Club membership card and a valid RS Clubman Competition Licence, this Licence is FREE and can be applied for online apart from under 18s who have to submit a form countersigned by a Parent or Guardian.

Registration

- 6 Registration forms must be returned **ONLY** to the Championship Co-ordinator either by post, email, directly or via the Secretary of the meeting at their first Championship round. As this is the third year of the resurrected Championship, Registration is **FREE** to encourage new entrants.

Points Scoring

- 7 Points awarded for the Overall Championship will be scored on the basis of 20 for 1st overall, 19th for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 20th place, between eligible competitors only. In addition 10 points will be awarded to 1st in class, 9 for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 10th, taking all competitors into account and based on event classes. Where only 2 competitors in a class start an event, points will be reduced to 9 for 1st, 8 for 2nd and if only 1 competitor in that class this will be reduced to 8 for 1st. All competitors will receive 1 point per event for starting that event. In addition **ALL** competitors will receive 1 point per event for finishing that event. As a substitute for **ONE** event score any Championship contender who, during the season acts as an official (including marshalling) on any of the Championship qualifying rounds may claim 10 points. Registered contenders will receive a form, those who wish to claim these points must submit this form signed by a senior official of the event to the Championship Co-ordinator within 7 days of the event. The Championship will consist of no more than 7 events of which a contender's best 5 scores will count. If there are only 5 or 6 rounds run the number of events

to count will be 4. If there are only 3 or 4 rounds run the number of events to count will be 3.

In the event of a tie in the Overall Championship, the better score in a discarded round will be counted to resolve the tie. If a tie persists, the second best discarded scores will be counted until the tie is resolved. If a tie still persists then the competitor who scored the greatest number of points first will be deemed to be the winner.

Results

8 Championship results will be published as soon as possible after each qualifying round on the SAMSC website / Facebook page and The Scottish Autotest Facebook page and Provisional Results will be published as soon as possible following the last event.

Classes

9 The Championship will consist of 6 Classes as follows -

1 Front Wheel Drive Cars

2 Rear Wheel Drive Cars

3 Mazda MX5s

4 Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars

5 Specials

6 Hybrid or Electric Powered Cars – **Must be Standard Production Cars**

Awards

10 1 st Overall	The Scottish Autotest Championship Trophy and an award
2 nd Overall	an award
1 st in Class subject to 3 Registrations	an award
1 st Novice subject to 3 Registrations	an award
1 st Junior subject to 3 Registrations	an award

A Novice is defined as a person not having been 1st in Class or better on more than 2 occasions on a Clubman event where the entry in the class was more than 2, and has never won the Novice Award before.

A Junior is defined as being aged 14 – 17 years

To win an award a competitor must score on at least 3 rounds in the Championship . To win a Class award a competitor must score on at least 3 rounds in the Championship in the same Championship Class.
