## Marshal's Advisory Group

### Key Updates

The Marshal's Advisory Group met virtually on 11 August 2021.

### Marshals' Pathway

Motorsport UK is continuing to develop and publicise the new Marshals' Pathway, which aims to increase participation across all disciplines, improving accessibility for new volunteers, and helping existing marshals develop their skills.

The July issue of Revolution provided details of the initial steps whereby all discipline-specific Trainee grades have been replaced with a 'Registered Marshal' grade which allows them to attend all branches of the sport under the supervision of someone with a higher grade. This change will help to drive volunteer participation across all disciplines of the sport, leading to a bigger pool of Marshals for the organising clubs to call upon.

Over the next 12 months, the marshalling family will be asked for their opinion on key topics to ensure that the Grading Scheme is replaced with a system that is not only fit for purpose for many years to come but has been created with input from the people within the community itself.
